



Announcement of Nakhon Ratchasima Province

Declaration of Commitment on Anti-Corruption

In accordance with the Commitment of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand (interim), B.E. 2557 (2014), Official Information Act, B.E. 2540 (1997), Royal Decree on Criteria and Procedures for Good Governance, B.E. 2546 (2003), National Anti-Corruption Strategy Phase 3 B.E. 2560-2564 (2017-2021) and Government Policy Article 10 on the promotion of good governance and prevention of corruption and misconduct in the public sector which prescribes the cultivation of values, morality, ethics, and conscience to uphold the integrity and etiquette of a public servant in tandem with effective government administration in order to prevent and suppress corruption and misconduct among all levels of public servant officials, and to respond to the public needs and offer convenience of public service in order to build trust and confidence in the government system.

Nakhon Ratchasima Province hereby issue policies on morality and transparency as a standard practice and values for public servants and personnel of the province to uphold and conduct together with the rules of law and other requirements, with determination to bring the departments to operate its missions with transparency, manage with honesty, morality and free from corruption. To achieve this intention, the government sectors under the Office of the Permanent Secretary for Interior shall uphold and proceed per the following guidelines:

1. Manage and operate on the basis of good governance, with an emphasis on responding to the publics needs with prompt, accuracy, equity, transparency and righteousness
2. Foster social values and attitudes to the personnel in the sectors with knowledge on morality and ethics as well as understanding of the Philosophy of Sufficiency Economy, so they can uphold and implement in the scope of work and daily life.
3. Conduct transaction on procurements with transparency throughout the process and allow the private sector, civil society and public sector to participate in the verification of the process by disclosing all forms of information and data of the operations and activities.
4. Publicize for the public sector to harness information, clues on corruptions and complaints through the Damrongdhama Center of Nakhon Ratchasima
5. Any corruptions will be investigated and if found guilty, shall be punished to the highest degree
